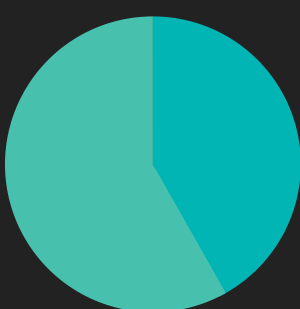

## PEOPLE WITH DISABILITIES ARE MARGINALIZED

ONLY 42% OF DISABLED PEOPLE ARE EMPLOYED
